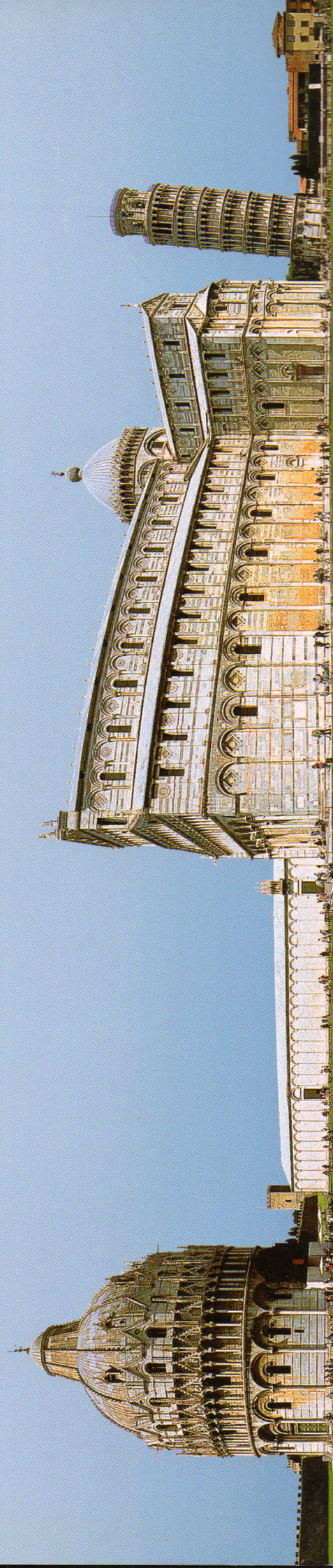
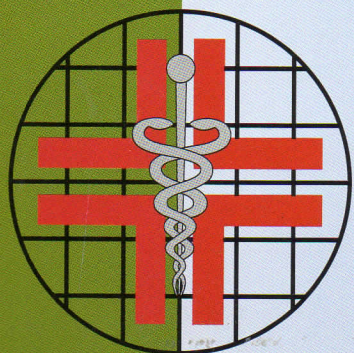

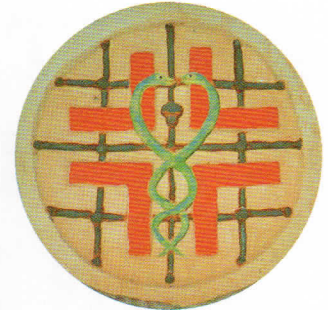

AMAPI (Associazione Medici Amministrazione Penitenziaria Italiana - Association of Doctors working in the Italian Penitentiary Administration) represents on national, regional and provincial basis all the Doctors, Paramedics and Sanitary Technicians who are professionally engaged in Penitentiary Establishments.

AMAPI has been founded in Rome following an initiative of Penitentiary Doctors of Regina Coeli.
